The Kingdom of Jordan was neighbouring the former British mandatory of Palestine, later being known as the State of Israel.

As 70% of Jordan's population are of Palestinian origin, either already living there or after fleeing from home during the catastrophe of expulsion Al-Nakba (النكبة), Jordan could be seen as an independent Palestinian community, especially because the kingdom became the only Arab state to offer full citizenship to refugees from Palestine without any social discrimination whatsoever. The Jordanian society can therefore make up for comparison when it comes to the characteristics of "The Palestinians" we are dealing with in this book










